

The Codroy Valley is a birders paradise. The Grand Codroy Estuary Ramsar Site is located in the mouth of the Grand Codroy River on a 924 hectare area recognized by the Convention of Wetlands of International Importance. This is a stopover for migrating fowl and a landing place for rare species occasionally blown off course. You will have the opportunity to see more species of birds here than anywhere else in the province.
